

2018 Mid Year Update



Welcome back to school everyone. It's hard to believe that it is already Term 3! What a wonderful and busy first half of the year it has been.

The PTA committee would like to take this opportunity to thank our wonderful school community for your energy and support so far this year that helps makes Marist a wonderful place for our children to learn, grow and develop strong friendships. As a state integrated school, we don't receive the same amount of funding as state schools, we therefore rely on the support of our community to enhance and enrich the learning environment, curriculum and resources of our school.

During Term 1 and 2 we held a mix of community and pastoral care events along with fundraisers which will support the purchase of new resources for the school and classrooms. Money raised has already provided our netball teams with 20 new uniforms, and other funds are set to purchase an easy pop-up gazebo with our Marist logo for use at sporting and interschool events, new scooter and bike racks to support interest in riding to school, and extra classroom resources asked for by our teachers.

Together these improvements will help make our green areas year-round spaces for Marist students and families to enjoy and explore. We are excited to start preparing for our major fundraiser – **the Mighty Marist Raffle** – and accompanying social evening for parents and friends. We will be looking to the school and wider community for prize donations – more details to come very soon!
